

GUIDELINES FOR MASS ATTENDEES

Bishop Knestout dispenses all of the faithful of the Diocese of Richmond from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days until further notice

- Anybody at risk or in a vulnerable category is strongly urged to remain home
- Masks are required for those age 10 and over.
- Try to show up at least 15 minutes early to Mass.
- Entry is through the double doors near the Day Chapel.
- Should the sanctuary capacity be reached there is extra seating available in the Fellowship Hall. Seating in the Sanctuary will be allotted first-come first-serve.
- Prior to entry there are a series of questions posted on the door. By entering, you attest that your answer is "No".
- You will be guided to your seat by an Usher.
- Music will be played, however singing is discouraged as it has been known to exacerbate the spread of Covid-19.
- The Communion receiving line will be dismissed by section.
- Daily Masses are held Tuesday through Friday at 8:00 AM.
- A Note on Livestreaming:
 - Livestreaming takes place at 8:00 AM Tuesday through Friday Daily Masses and the 5:00 PM Saturday Vigil Mass
