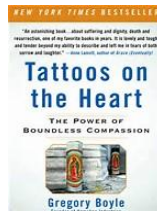

CHRISTIAN FORMATION:

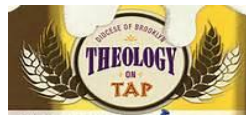
