The parish nurses say: Mosquito bites can cause severe illness although they usually are just annoying. One way to avoid mosquito bites is to avoid the outdoors during the dusk and dawn hours of the day. Screens should be repaired and insect repellent containing DEET, or Oil of Eucalyptus should be used when outdoors. In addition, long pants and long sleeve shirts should also be worn.
